Growth rate	Description
M	Wonderfully fragrant, rich pink flowers May and June with glossy foliage that turns orange-red in fall.
S	Formal in appearance, wider and more dense than other firs with green cones in youth that turn pale brown when mature.
S	Slow growing, small-statured, compact tree; green needles with white undersides and showy purple 3" cones
S	Stately and elegant fir with almost black-green needles.
S	Handsome and unusual form with irregular branching and curled needles that reveal silvery-white undersides.
M	Multi-stemmed or low branching maple with attractive 5 lobed sharply toothed leaf, red twigs and red fall color.
S	Dense foliage branching low to the ground; yellow fall color.
S	Young leaves red, green in maturity, red leaf stems. One of the most heat-tolerant snakebark maples.
S	Compact, slow growing, scarlet to purple fall color.
M	Dense, shrubby with red fruits and fiery red fall color.
M	Multi-stemmed small tree or large shrub with glossy dark green leaves, variable fall color and showy fall fruit.
S	Outstanding cinnamon brown, exfoliating bark; good red and orange fall color.
S	Lacy dissected foliage; beautiful orange red fall colors, needs protection from winter wind.
S	9-13 deeply cut lobes in large green leaf; bright yellow, orange, scarlet red fall color
S	9-11 deeply cut lobes in a large palmate shaped leaf; bright orange red yellow fall color;
S	Lacy foliage with orange red fall color, needs protection from winter wind.
M	Trifoliolate insect and disease free leaves, early red fall color.
M	A narrow pyramidal tree with small, 3 lobed obtuse leaves; showy red fruit. Tolerates alkaline, rocky soils and dry conditions.
S	Handsome burgundy foliage all season. Needs a protected site.
S	Crimson red foliage, cascading branches, scarlet fall color. Protect from winter wind.
S	Bark and older stems are green striped with white; leaves vibrant yellow in fall. The only native snakebark maple native to North America.
S	Lovely small tree that is very cold hardy - a good substitute for Acer palmatum in Zones 4-5.
S	11-13 lobes, deeply cut; green-yellow to gold and red vivid fall colors
S	11-13 lobes, deeply cut; green to yellow orange red fall colors
S	Shrubby, small short trunked with bushy appearance. Leaves dark yellow-green changing to yellow, orange and red.
S	Outstanding small maple with trifoliolate leaves that turn yellow and red (overall orange) in fall. Bark is narrowly fissured. Requires acid soil.
S	Emerging leaves are reddish purple turning dark glossy green and then yellow-orange-red in fall. Drought tolerant.
M	Beautiful red leaf stems, new growth red turning green, orange-red fall color.
F	Deep mustard yellow flowers to 5" in diameter.
F	Soft lilac pink flowers.
F	Masses of attractive intense deep red flowers over a long period. Strong upright stems.
F	Large 3-4" wide golden-yellow flower heads June - Oct and fern-like foliage.
F	Intense ruby-red flower clusters with gold centers fading to light pink and creamy yellow.
F	Double white variety.
F	Soft pink flowers in large umbels June through Sept and dark green serrated foliage.

F	Fast growing, twining vine with edible fruit. Needs strong support.
F	Young leaves purplish, variegated with white to pink splashes on mature (3-5 yr) plants. Male plants tend to have showy leaf coloration.
S	Large suckering shrub with showy 8-12" 'Bottlebrush' white flowers and 1" buckeye fruit.
S	Showy bright red 4-8" tubular flowers and 1-2" buckeye fruits. Leaves somewhat tropical in appearance.
M	Handsome large leaves (5-7 leaflets); reddish fall color; 6-10" panicles of pink-white flowers
	Bubble gum-scented foliage and rose colored flowers.
	Lavender blue flowers, striking gold scented foliage.
	Orange and lavender flowers, gray-green scented foliage.
F	Large purple-leaved plant with purple flower spikes.
	Gray-green foliage with tiny yellow-green starry flowers in late spring that can be dried.
M	White flowers in spring, dark blue 3/8" fruit and yellow to red fall color. Acid soil.
M	April white flowers, edible blue berries, orange to red fall colors, acid soil.
M	Early april white flowers, blue berry, glossy foliage, orange-red fall color, acid soil.
M	Early april white flowers, blue berry, orange-red fall color, acid soil.
F	Deeply incised 5 lobes white-pink-green leaf; bright blue berries, vigorous grower.
F	Large kidney shaped green leaf with abundant purple funnel-shaped flowers and attractive ribbed seed capsules.
F	Small refined heart-shaped leaves, greenish yellow flowers and decorative 'hot air balloon shaped seed pods. Sun and heat tolerant.
F	Twining vine; coarse bold dark green heart shaped leaves 6-10" long giving dense shade.
S	White flowers, shining green leaf, black fruit, bright orange fall color
S	Compact form with lustrous simple green foliage, white flowers, heavy fruiting, bright wine-red fall foliage.
S	White flowers, lustrous green leaf, large 1/2" edible black berries, and red fall color.
S	Woodland native with hear-shaped leaves, spreads by short rhizomes requires humus rich soil. More heat tolerant than the European form.
S	Kidney shaped, leathery, glossy evergreen leaves. Brown insignificant flower. Best in shaded area with slightly acidic soil.
M	Purple 6 petal flowers, 12" 'tropical' looking foliage; yellow fall color; tasty fruit.
M	Outstanding, tough, rich looking ground cover with large glossy dark green leaves and clusters of show rose-pink flowers.
M	Dark pink to purple-red flowers in early spring and foliage sometimes purple, especially in fall.
M	Exquisite orange-red-brown bark, peeling off in thin exfoliating sheets.
M	Showy exfoliating white bark; lustrous dark green leaves going to a fall yellow.
S	Dwarf form, showy white bark, green leaf going to yellow in fall
S	Dark rich glossy green leaves and exfoliating bark, white to salmon-white. Yellow fall color.
M	Large mounding shrub of ascending branches. Showy white bark.
M	Chalky white bark, tolerates wet, dry and poor soils.
	Sky-blue "Forget-me-not" flowers in May and June. Handsome lush foliage.
S	Small dark green leaves, wide oval form; very hardy.
S	Rounded and full; good winter color; small dark green leaves.

S	Somewhat loose and open in habit, very hardy, winter color tends to be bronze.
S	Handsome light green small leaf form that is excellent as a low hedge.
F	Variegated form of Karl Foerster, wide white center stripe on each leaf, feathery gold plumes to 4' in early summer. Does well in heavy soils.
F	Dependable, non-re seeding reed grass.
F	Creamy white edged leaves in compact clumps with pink plumes on 36" stems in early summer.
F	Tiny lilac thyme-like flowers over long period, delicious mild scented foliage.
F	Bright yellow-green leaves lie in one plane with showy purple berry clusters.
S	Spicily fragrant purple-red flowers, brown leathery fruit capsules, gray-green leaf.
M	Clumping with green spiked seed heads
M	Spreading groundcover with bright white margins
M	Upright bright yellow variegated foliage good for wet areas
S	Fine textured dark green foliage turning yellow/orange/red; fluted, smooth gray bark resembling flexed muscles.
S	Small dark green leaves with showy yellow, red and orange fall color; showy catkins.
S	Handsome foliage, deeply impressed dark green leaf,
S	Small glossy serrated leaf and drooping catkins.
S	Colorful red foliage in spring and fall; showy catkins.
F	Glossy green summer foliage that is late to leaf out; creamy white globular flower heads about 1" across in June, July and August; likes wet soils.
M	Weeping form of the Katsura. Sensitive to drought
M	Dwarf form of the Katsura. Beautiful heart shaped emerging red leaf changing to bright green in summer to apricot in fall Sensitive to drought
F	Weeping form of the Katsura. Sensitive to drought
F	Weeping form of the Katsura. Sensitive to drought
M	Heart shaped leaves emerge reddish-purple, turn bright green in summer and apricot in the fall. Grow as a single or multi-trunked spec. Sensitive to drought.
M	Purple-pink blooms on gracefully arching branches. Green heart-shaped leaves turn yellow in fall. Grows in acid or alkaline soil.
M	Variegated form of the Eastern Redbud.
M	Heart shaped leaf , red-purple then green, and yellow in fall; showy spring red-purple flowers hang in strings, effective 3 weeks acid or alkaline soil.
M	Showy red-purple blooms in spring followed by shiny, lustrous bright green foliage.
M	Yellow appressed foliage; compact and full
M	Semi-dwarf, dense , globose bush, thread-like foliage.
M	Dwarf green dense appressed foliage.
M	Dwarf mounding bright gold thread-like foliage.
M	Lustrous leathery foliage; beautiful white flower panicles peeling gray bark
S	Lovely, fine fleecy white flower panicles, lustrous green foliage, blue berries.
M	Showy white flowers cover the tree like white rain, fragrant. Bright yellow-green foliage going to summer bright green, acid or alkaline soil; prune only in summer
F	Shrubby perennial with blue flowers in July.
	Abundant, small, white star shaped flowers in September.
M	Deep, deep purple.
